Description

This chest of drawers is equipped with four dovetail drawers ensuring perfect solidity.

The drawers can be opened daily and hold many sometimes heavy objects. They slide perfectly.

The "heart" entrances are discreet and do not protrude from the surface. They are brass. The keys are later than the chest of drawers.

The back of the dresser has solid wood panels so very resistant.

The dresser is perfectly stable. It rests on low feet that respect the shape of the furniture at the front and are called "skate feet" and two straight feet at the back.
