



Painting By Georges Jeannin (1841-1925) "flowers On An Entablature"



Description

Superb and rare large format painting by Georges JEANNIN representing a rich entablature of multiple flowers, extremely decorative, with its original black ebony frame with stylized gold decoration, on its original canvas, signed lower left. A great specialist in floral compositions, these bouquets are treated with broad brush strokes in a generous paste, in the impressionist manner from 1880, the period of our painting. He was a student of Victor VINCELET, STARTED AT THE SALON OF 1868, and there exhibited regularly, obtained an honorable mention in 1876 and a medal of 3 class in 1878, a second in 1888. At the universal exhibition of 1889 and that of 1900, he received a bronze medal for these exhibited works, and the legion of honor in Paris also in 1903. Particularly renowned and gifted for
