Pearl diameter: approximately 7/7.5 mm. Total weight of diamonds: approximately 0.10 carat. Proportions: Height: approximately 13.8 mm, width: approximately 14.8 mm, thickness: approximately 8.5 mm, width of the ring at the base: approximately 1.6 mm. Net weight: approximately 3.4g. Our opinion: A lovely pearl diamond ring that is reminiscent of old rings from the Belle Epoque.
