circa 1880. Coming from a castle in Agenais.

Kerman is the largest city in southeastern Iran. It
is the capital of the province of Kerman.
The deep harmony of colors results from a perfect
dosage which testifies to the great creativity of
Kirman artisans.
Kirman rugs are remarkably fine, the most
appreciated and sought after by collectors.

Although this piece presents a general state of
wear, it nevertheless remains a unique piece.
Its pistachio color confirms its authenticity to the
"Laver" family, also known as "Raver", which
gives it greater notoriety.
