

Tatanua Mask, Malagan Mask, Tabar Islands, Papua New Guinea, Oceanic Art, Tribal Art



Description

Rare Malagan dance mask collected from the Tabar Islands in Papua New Guinea. This mask called "Tatanua" represents the soul available to a person and is used during commemoration ceremonies. These relatively light wooden masks are worn during ritual dances. This was notably used during a large ceremony organized in February 2020 on the island of Tatau. Wood, plant fibers (notably coconut and pandanus), coconut bark, pigments and shells. Sold with a presentation base. 46 x 21 x 43 cm / EUR1700 base and shipping costs included.
