It is located on rue de la Chaussée in Morteau in Doubs (25). - The company was able to create a style in full Art-Nouveau with very artisanal and high quality manufacturing methods, their art was practiced over two generations from 1864 to 1930. - Logo of the factory in a square and the word Registered and the numbers 399658,34, letter OIle all engraved on the bowl. - Bowl, edge
