Large pitcher vase signed Roger Capron in Vallauris in white earthenware with flared neck, polychrome enameled decoration in reserve called "pajamas". 50s/60s. Very good condition Height 25.5cm Diameter 16cm at the collar Signed on the back Capron Vallauris and the letter T CAPRON Roger (1922-2006) Professor of Applied Arts, Capron was first interested in drawing. He discovered ceramic work in Vallauris before Picasso, and created the Callis workshop with Robert Picault. He founded his own workshop in 1952 and sold his collections notably in the United States at the Saks Fifth Avenue department store. He received awards at numerous international exhibitions in
