

Mr. Étex, for whom the difficulties of execution do not seem to exist, strives above all to capture the intellectual expression of the model and to show us the character with the help of the physiognomy. The busts of MM. Sapey and Odilon Barrot have not only a very real likeness, they are also perfectly living. This is indeed the fine and thoughtful physiognomy of the political tactician (Odilon Barrot), like the somewhat Olympian look of the orator who is about to unleash the thunderbolts of his speech. The bust of Mme Adolphe Barrot, by the same artist, shows the flexibility of his talent.
