Bronze sculpture representing a goose walking with a snail on its beak.

Rare and sought-after subject of the artist.

Vintage cast iron from Susse Frères, circa 1925.

Beautiful carving and nuanced brown patina in superb condition.

Signature of the artist on the terrace and of the founder "Susse Frs Edts Paris" on the side.

Edition between 1918 and 1930 of 110 pieces.

Circular founder's stamp on the back with letter V.

Height 10.1cm x Length 19.7cm

Excellent state of conservation.
