Bronze Sculpture "girl crocheting" Eugène Laurent Signed on the terrace, total height 57.5cm.

Eugène Laurent (1832-1898), French sculptor, began by studying sculpture under the direction of Théodore Coinchon (1814-1881). Regularly participating in the Salon of French Artists, Laurent quickly acquired a good reputation as a classical sculptor and became famous. He participated for the first time in the Salon in 1861. He became known for his classic subjects, his bust portraits of celebrities and was chosen to create public monuments, such as his Jacques Callot in Nancy, and his François Boucher, exhibited at the Paris City Hall.
