Enameled silver-gilt sewing kit from the first half of the 19th century. The blackened wooden box is inlaid with mother-of-pearl and brass inlays. There are very small imperfections, but the overall appearance is very nice, with a beautiful French polish. The scissors are enameled silver-gilt (gold-plated silver). One of the branches is very damaged, but not broken. It is also missing a lot of its enamel. The needle case and awl are in fairly good condition with beautiful enamel.
