They show board games in use at the beginning of the 19th century, the "colin maillard" which is still very well known today: the main player is blindfolded and must recognize the other players by groping, and " the hot hand" where the main player must recognize which of the other players is spanking him.

The engravings are very amusing, full of picturesque characters, with many small details in the decor depicting the daily life inside an inn or farm at the beginning of the 19th century.
