Description

The old watercolor church signed and dated 1932 and located Saint Briac Marcel Oudin was born on December 10, 1882 and died on November 11, 1936 in Paris. Coming from a modest family, he entered the School of Decorative Arts in Paris in 1900 at the age of 18. Despite a fragile constitution, he has an impressive capacity for work. He won first prizes in architecture and geometry and entered the competitions at the "Salon" where works by artists from the Society of French Artists were exhibited. At the "Arts Déco", he followed the teachings of Charles Genuys (1852-1928) he was named Knight of the Legion of Honor in 1930 for his participation in the reconstruction of regions devastated by the Great War. Finally, he is part of the main groups of architects of his generation: Graduate
