According to the creations of Charles Cressent: very important Minister's desk in exceptional Regency style circa 1900, Parisian creation from the beginning of the 20th century. made of violet, amaranth and satin wood and enhanced with beautiful chiseled and gilded bronzes. Leather covers a sinuous top surrounded by an ingot mold with leafy spandrels. The sinuous belt opens to three drawers, each framed with bronze rods with drop handles. The middle drawer, narrower and set back. Scraps of epaulettes adorn the pinch of the top of the legs. Abundantly arched feet ending in bronze slippers Period circa 1900. Dimensions: h82x187x95
