Description

Offering plate also known as a "quest dish" made of embossed brass engraved in a round shape representing a scene of Adam and Eve.

A man and a woman, divided on either side of an apple tree, with a woman on the left, the right arm raised under a branch and the open hand towards an apple, and on the right a man, the arm and fingers raised towards Eve.

The Protestantism present at this period takes up part of the Old Testament, telling the story of Adam and Eve through many decorations, especially those of the dishes for offering, as evidenced by this object that tells the story in which Eve is preparing to eat the fruit that Adam reminds her that God defended them.

The central stage is surrounded by interlacing branches.
