





Some foxing, rubbed surfaces. Burnand (1850-1921), Swiss artist working in France, great painter and wonderful designer, is being rediscovered after a long period of relative oblivion. If his painting "The Apostles Peter and John running towards the tomb of the risen Christ" at the Musée d'Orsay is almost part of the collective unconscious, collectors are now discovering his highly precise naturalistic drawings.
