Pretty clock in white marble and gilded bronze representing Venus fueling the fire of Love, the enameled dial signed Meuer in Paris for François Meyer, master watchmaker registered in 1773. The dial has chips, the wire movement seems to operate striking the hours and a half, key and bell present, the pendulum brought back? beautiful condition of the original gilding small chips of time on the marble. Dust cover present. It rests on four gadrooned feet. Louis XVI period work 18th century. Length 31cm width 15cm height 29cm.

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
