Description

Small marble head representing a bearded man in profile, an apostle or a prophet. This sculpture comes from the Joseph Altounian collection dispersed during the Artcurial sale of September 18, 2019. It bears on the reverse the typical label of the Joseph Altounian collections Ref: Annex 622. Our sculpture has been cited as coming from the close circle of Giovanni Pisano. Without being able to state this attribution with certainty, our marble nevertheless belongs to the Tuscan school of the early 14th century, under the influence of sculptors such as Pisano or Giovanni di Balduccio. The connection with the latter is interesting, Giovanni di Balducio produced capitals and funerary reliefs with representations very close to our marble. Early 14th century.
