Extraordinary because we could compare it to a horse's head Extraordinary because we read, carved in hollow S.MODE, but no matter how much I searched, Saint Mode is not included in my pantheons... Surprising the place where This name is engraved and does not seem apparent if the bust is placed above a breastplate. Surprising because the back side is flat, as if it were an element of an altarpiece (or a statue intended for a pillar). Surprising the style of the ears, I don't know the origin.
