Student of Georges Callot, William Bouguereau, Gustave Moreau and Émile Charles Dameron, he exhibited in 1899 at the Salon of French Artists, at the Luxembourg Museum as an army painter in 1918, at the Galerie Allard (1920) and at the Galerie Georges Petit (1925) as well as,
