JAPAN - Edo period (1603-1868) KABUTO composed of 62 wrought iron strips. THEHEN NO ANA (opening at the top) in gilded copper with four degrees topped with a blooming lotus. SHIKORO (neck cover) with three degrees in black lacquered iron and blue, orange and white silk braid. FUKIGAESHI (fins) in black lacquered iron stamped with a Mon. MABI SA SHI (visor) in wrought iron MAEDATE in lacquered and gilded wood depicting a crescent moon. Possibility of exchanging this mandate with one in carved and partially red lacquered wood representing the head of an oni with a large ear, the forehead centered on a long horn or a metal maedate repeating the mon already present on the fins. Samurai half mask called MEMPO in lacquered iron. The pronounced chin, large brown Dealer
