After training at the National School of Decorative Arts, he led a very classic artistic career. He painted decorative frescoes for several public monuments including the castle and the Town Hall of Vincennes, his town of residence where he died in 1980. He also dealt with religious and historical subjects, multiplied the still lifes and was inspired by the landscapes that he discovers during his walks. He likes to paint the forests of Ile de France and the Breton coastline. Also an admirer of mountainous sites, he joined the Society of Mountain Painters. Having family in Mayenne, Paul Delormoz regularly stays in
