A Decor inspired by rare carpets from the Safavid dynasty under Shah Abbas I the great. A ruby red field with an original decoration of hunting animals surrounded by birds taking flight and decorated with seedlings of bulbs and palmettes of flowers decorated with fine stems with foliage very finely drawn in polychrome.
