Pair of elegant flat-backed armchairs in finely molded and carved beech wood, cream relacquered (pretty quality lacquer), the top called a gendarme's hat decorated with twisted ribbons and burst pomegranates, the tapered, fluted and roughened legs (old restoration) Stamped by Dupain, the stamp is round in shape, difficult to "see" but present for Adrien Dupain, he is a skilled carpenter, master in 1772, he obtained orders for royal residences and, in particular, for the Queen's service at Saint Cloud Classic and elegant model, well made, these seats are well upholstered, cover perhaps to be revised?
