Large 18th century engraving in the style of red chalk, by Desmarteau, representing the head of a disheveled young man. The Desmarteaus invented this technique of imitating red chalk, and had great success. They engraved for the greatest artists of the 18th century, and distributed very spectacular images, like this one. a few stains, small accidents, an old master key, and a Louis XVI style frame (from the 19th century), give this object the charm of experience.
