French painter, studied at the School of Fine Arts in the workshop of André Devambez. At 16, he successively lost his entire family and his in-laws took a major place in his life by marrying Irène, the daughter of Emile Bernard with whom he studied painting. The couple traveled to Italy and settled in Venice in 1921. From their first trip to Indochina they brought back reconstructions of Angkor presented at the Colonial Expo of 1931; He visited Spain, Egypt and India from 1948 to 1958.
