Officer's sword with an entirely silver mount and a donkey, Louis XV° - LOUIS XVI° - XVIII° period. Silver swords are awarded to elite corps or are decorated for high-ranking military or civilian figures. Frame entirely in silver with chiseled olive pommel. Fully filigreed fuse with silver braided upper and lower ring. Chiseled joining arch and donkey bearing 3 hallmarks on the branch of the donkey, goldsmith and title. Pontats and escutcheon chiseled with trophies made up of helmets, flags, drums, flowers, scrolls etc... Strong blade with triangular section with 3 sides and median edge 82 cm long and 2.5 cm wide at the heel.
