Original proof made in 1757 by Georges Louis The RED cartographer. Taken from the "Recueil des Cotes Maritimes de France" published by Desnos. With the half fleur-de-lys indicating the North, the depth of the waters near the rocks, the woods, the watercourses, the reliefs... Particularly detailed coastal survey, on the scale of 2 half-leagues, carried out by George the Red, military engineer of fortifications and geographer to King Louis XV. He was also military engineer to the Count of Clermont, engraver, publisher and print dealer. Beautiful hand watercolor colors.
