Description

French school circa 1820/30: "Portrait of a man in a coat", oil on canvas 81 x 65 cm, mounted in a superb gilded frame 109 x 88 cm. A masterful restoration accompanied by re-lining has revealed the old repaintings which camouflaged the coat and the signature incised on the handle of the brush (L....). Still in the neo-classical vein, in his attitude he is already in the nascent romanticism: the collar wide open, barely tightened by a blue scarf which contrasts with the yellow jacket, the man closes his blue coat with one hand -night with black reverses. The face with its slightly aquiline nose, full of intelligence and kindness, makes me think of different personalities of the time: Victor Hugo, Ingres or Talma. This sumptuous portrait was probably published in engraving, so if an Internet user recognizes the
