Circular stamp of the founder "Society Of Paris Bronzes" , on the back of the terrace .

Old edition sculpture , period second part of the 19th century .

Very good state of conservation and patina .

Many of his works were rewarded at the French Artists' Salon and at the Universal Exhibitions of 1889 and 1900 .

Salon of French Artists : Honorable Mention (1882) , 3rd Class Medal (1885) , 2nd Class Medal (1888) .

Universal Exhibition : Bronze medal (1889) , 1st class medal (1898) , Silver medal (1900) .

Many works by Henri - Louis Levasseur have been published in bronze, often in several dimensions , in particular by the "Society Of Paris Bronzes" , but also by "Siot - Decauville" and "Thiébaud".

The works of Henri - Louis Levasseur are today part of the collections of the Pushkin State Museum of Fine Arts in Moscow , the Grohmann Museum of the Milwaukee School of Engineering and the Columbia Art Museum .
