student of Paul Delaroche in Paris and became a renowned painter in 1841 by obtaining the second Rome Prize for the historical landscape with Adam and Eve expelled from the Terrestrial Paradise. He spent two years in Italy between 1842 and 1844 and stayed in Florence, Rome, Genoa and Naples. This trip to Italy will strongly influence his artistic productions.
