Description

The Louis XVI style display case in question is a masterpiece of late 19th century cabinetmaking, embodying the elegance and sophistication characteristic of that era. This piece of marquetry veneer furniture is distinguished by its refined decor, notably by its Greek fillets and simulated fluting, which evoke the classic and geometric motifs popular during the reign of Louis XVI. notable element of this display case. The bronze falls which adorn the upper uprights are delicately chiseled, bringing a touch of luxury and refinement. The legs are decorated with round bronze rings, reinforcing the harmony and stylistic coherence of the piece of furniture. These gilded bronze details highlight the know-how of the artisans of the time, combining both aesthetics and functionality. The top of the display case is topped with marble speckled in various colors, typical of luxury creations of this period. This marble not only adds a touch of visual richness, but it also provides a strong and durable surface. The rounded uprights, in half-columns, give the piece of furniture a classic and structured elegance, characteristic of the Louis XVI style. With dimensions of 157 cm in height, 70 cm in width and 39 cm in depth, this display case is proportioned to fit harmoniously into various interior spaces, without compromising its display capacity. It is large enough to hold and display a collection of objects, while remaining a manageable size for most domestic or display environments.
