Imposing oak window elements dating from the mid-20th century.

Ideal set for arranging a luxurious library or organizing a collection of objects to protect from dust.

The doors in fact have flexible "lips" making the openings relatively watertight.

The cast iron cremones stamped "CF" and a marine anchor come from the Camion Frères company in Vivier-au-Court, located 9 km from Charleville-Mézières in the Ardennes.

The oak structure is very well made.
