The water carrier or the source Edouard Drouot 1859-1945 orientalist bronze with brown patina full of details (cactus source pretty drape) beautiful patina and beautiful carving sand cast around 1910 signed on the terrace. Edouard Drouot (1859-1945) French sculptor Édouard Drouot was a French artist known for his bronze and marble sculptures of allegorical and mythological scenes. Sometimes creating animal and orientalist works, Drouot's sculptures, whether of animals or people, are characterized by a sense of movement and an expressive touch. Born April 3, 1859 in Sommevoire, France, he studied with Mathurin Moreau at the École nationale supérieure des beaux-arts de Paris and exhibited at the Paris Salon from 1889. Today, Drouot's work is found, between others, in the
