Enameled box, decorated with gallant scenes and landscape views.

The whole, on a manganese grid background, presents the different scenes in gold-enhanced cartouches.

The silver-rimmed lid opens onto a view of a landscape.

Work from the Louis XV period.

The silver setting bears 18th century hallmarks. Visible cracks in the enamel; Slight lack inside the lid.

This box relates to so-called "virtue" objects.
