Netsuke in painted wood and Negoro lacquer, representing a smiling actor with a fan.

"Negoro lacquer was developed by the priests of Negoro Temple in Wakayama centuries ago. The priests used a red-on-black lacquer technique [...] for all kinds of objects, including netsukes. The clues of the artisanal origin of Negoro netsukes are visible in their productions; which are perfectly functional, simple and robust; in the decoration, which is minimal [...] and in the absence of signatures."
