worked, first of all, in the workshops of Jouve,

Rivier and Chambost ,then created their own

workshop in 1956. They developed an enamel red

which met with international success, then

created1960 new cooking methods. Their work

was, then, most often utilitarian and decorative.

They created models for Haviland in 1964, and

collaborated on interior decoration projects with

certain architects for the Lafayette and Air France

galleries, carried out commissions for Mitsukoshi
