Henri-Charles Angéniol (1870-1959) studied at the School of Fine Arts in both Lyon and Paris taking lessons with the painter Tony Tollet and then later worked in the studio of the artist Gustave Moreau.

He exhibited his paintings at the 'Salon des Artistes Français' in Paris from 1904 to 1914. He exhibited his works continuously at the 'Société lyonnaise des Beaux-Arts' from 1919 to 1959.

He was praised by the press of the period for his ability to portray subjects in their intimate expressiveness in everyday moments. His painting was defined as 'intimist painting'.

He exhibited his paintings at the 'Salon de Paris' from 1890. The frame and oil paintings are professionally restored.
