A strong symbolism is associated with these statues, four in number (the four parts of time). The late Julien de Nemours rests in this tomb. The particularity of these andirons is their positioning on a box base. The original statues are on a broken double-arched pediment, this curved base is for example reproduced in the Barbedienne andirons on the same subject.
