After World War I he began to exhibit his landscapes, especially urban landscapes of old Milan, in group exhibitions. He devoted himself to depicting wet landscapes of Milan's canals and Venetian lagoons. After his death, he was buried at Milan's Monumental Cemetery. The City of Milan after his death named a street after him.
