Alfred LAVERGNE Nontron (Dordogne), 1892 -Suresnes (Hauts-de-Seine), 1969 Oil on canvas Signed lower right "Alfred Lavergne" Located on the back "Santeuil" 38 x 47 cm (57 x 65 cm with the frame) Very beautiful Montparnasse in carved wood Originally from Périgord, Alfred Lavergne went to Paris in 1919 where he trained at the School of Fine Arts in the studio of Fernand Cormon. After settling in Montmartre in the 1920s, he moved to the Montparnasse district in 1932, at 12, rue du Moulin-de-Beurre, in a workshop that he did not leave until 1962, with the expropriation of the workshops on rue du Moulin-de-Beurre. Lavergne exhibited at the Salon of Independents for thirty years from 1921 and he was a member of the Salon of French Artists, where he obtained an honorable mention
