A commanding bust representation of the French Emperor Napoleon I, depicted in military uniform with a cocked hat, collared tunic, and campaign greatcoat. His expression is inspired and resolute. The hollow one-piece base bears the artist's signature on the side, and the bust features classic imperial iconography, including the monogram "N" and a radiant star. Executed in green-patinated plaster, the finish reinforces the martial character of the subject. Late 19th century. Height: 66 cm Width: 46 cm Given the atypical dimensions and the use of plaster--a material rarely seen in other versions--we hypothesize that this piece may be a working prototype used as a model for casting bronze editions.
