.He participated in work on the pair of monumental frescoes commissioned from the leading Victorian artist Frederic Leighton in 1868 to decorate the south courtyard of the recently opened South Kensington Museum in London (now the Victoria and Albert Museum)

- Trained at the National Art Training School and then the Royal Academy Schools, he later returned to his first alma mater to teach painting before being promoted to assistant principal of the Royal College of Art, recently renamed the Royal College of Art, in 1900 -
