Member of the French Artists from 1900, he obtained a medal there. He exhibited at the Universal Exhibition of 1900. Algeria. Avoiding the impressionist wave that was spreading in Europe in the late 19th and early 20th centuries, his training brought him closer to academic art, and he seemed to take inspiration from Jean-Léon Gérôme (1824-1904) and 'Henri Biva (1848-1929). He enjoyed early success for his large compositions - in 1898 he won the Brizard Prize of 3,000 francs, awarded by the Academy of Fine Arts for his painting "En Aiglard", which also received a mention at the Salon de Paris - He produced paintings paying particular attention to details and perfectly mastering the play of reflections and light on still water.
