Silver ciborium of the sick with a wide flat base decorated with a chiseled flowered cross. Stem is frustoconical, forming a bulb assembled in two interlocking parts serving as a reserve for Saint Chrism. Cup is of flattened circular shape, silver gilded inside. The slightly domed lid is topped with a cross surrounded by a corolla of leaves. With his spatula. 950/1000 silver, old woman's head hallmarks, 1819-1838 City of Sens (Burgundy) Master Goldsmith hallmark: initial P
