French School from the second part of the 19th century, oil on canvas representing the full-frontal bust portrait of a quality lady presented in a false oval, this small canvas in its original frame has a handwritten note on the frame of the painting " Countess of Segur" We have few portraits of the writer, however a portrait of the Countess made by her son Fabien de Segur at an unknown date presents strong resemblances to a few more years of the subject.
