Porcelain plate decorated in Holland in the Kakiemon style decorated with quails and millet. The border is richly decorated with prunus on a green enameled crackled background. Roosters also appear in cartouches alternating with quails. On the reverse, a Jue jug in a double circle. China 18TH

Kangxi Period CIRCA 1720.

Diameter: 22cm

The quality of the decoration and the presence of roosters may suggest that it is a decoration from the Yongzheng period, on porcelain from the Kangxi period.
