Pretty regulator clock in mahogany and blackened wood. The movement is framed by 4 mahogany veneered columns with gilded bronze inlay fillets as well as the bases and capitals. This clock rests on a wooden base and nets on four small spinning top feet. It is covered with a large glass globe. The dial is marked: Place des victoires. At the back of the movement is a medal marked VINCENTI et CIE, 19th century watchmaker. Good condition of house without overhaul. Works and chimes half and hour. She has her key. 2 small bronze threads are missing. Dimensions: Total height with the globe: 60 cm, width: 28 cm, thickness: 19 cm Height of the pendulum: 41 cm, width: 24 cm, thickness: 13 cm.
