Rare and important double-sided Museum display case in Renaissance style in walnut and magnifying glass. This piece of furniture was made in the 19th century to be placed in the center of a room and would have been used for a Museum or a department store. The 4 sides are admirably cared for at the level of the finish the facades are composed as follows: face A: it opens with 9 leaves including 2 glazed with original rays and 1 with mirror + 17 drawers in total / the central part is decorated with arched columns with a bottom of mirror side B: it opens with 4 leaves and the upper part with shelf serves as a Bibus bookcase, a gadrooned cornice with ogee surrounds the piece of furniture at the base of the top giving this masterpiece of furniture a particular personality and elegance for
