Description

Louis XVI period marquetry cylinder desk. It opens with a cylinder, three drawers in the intermediate part, a writing tablet and a large drawer in the belt. Decorated with flowers on the cylinder, rests on four sheathed feet. Ornaments of gilded and chiseled bronzes. White-gray marble top surrounded by a gallery. Stamped by Jean-Baptiste VASSOU (1739-1807), received master in 1767. Louis XVI period. Jean-Baptiste Vassou (1739-1807) - Carpenter-cabinetmaker. Paris. Master on January 28, 1767.
